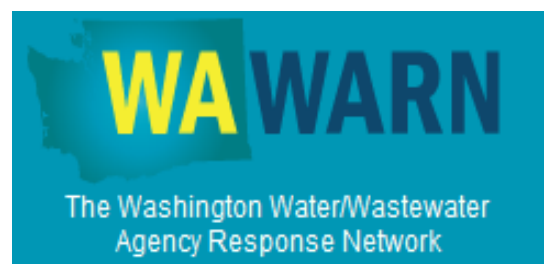

Do you ever worry that you won't have ***what you really need*** to respond to a water or wastewater emergency? The Washington State Water and Wastewater Agency Response Network (**WAWARN**) is a network of "utilities helping utilities." This network helps water and wastewater utilities locate emergency assistance in the form of personnel, equipment, materials and services.



Event Description: **WAWARN** is hosting a one-day functional exercise (FE) for water and wastewater owners and operators, emergency management staff, and response partners from local, state and federal agencies. The FE will provide an opportunity for participants to test their emergency response capabilities, specifically but not limited to: communications, resource management, documentation and mutual aid and assistance during an incident affecting water and wastewater utilities.

This FE is open to **WAWARN** member utilities and non-member utilities, public works agencies, as well as response partners that are interested in learning more about water sector mutual aid. Visit <http://www.wawarn.org> for more information about the **WAWARN** program.
